MISSION





Some ALARMING STATISTICS

A survey published this week claimed that a <u>third of South African adults are regular drug users</u>, dagga use has risen by 11% in the past year and the use of methamphetamines by a staggering 88% (Africa Check 28/03/2013). [Let's remember that drug abuse <u>normally starts at a very young age</u> - at school].

The National Council on Alcoholism and Drug Dependence says statistics show that <u>drug abuse is on the rise</u> <u>particularly among youngsters in South Africa</u>. <u>Marijuana and alcohol</u> are among the most commonly used drugs in South Africa (SABC 26/06/2013).

1 in 10 in SA has addiction problem (health24.com 19/06/2013)

Half of SA teens drink alcohol (news24 Feb. 2012) - closer to 2 out of 3 teens drink alcohol (in 2015).

"in developing countries, <u>STDs and their complications are amongst the top five disease categories</u> for which adults seek health care. In women of childbearing age, STDs (excluding HIV) are second only to maternal factors as causes of disease, death and healthy life lost" (avert.org).


"<u>South Africa has a huge teen pregnancy problem</u> - <u>one in three girls</u> has had a baby by the age of 20," David Harrison, Chief Executive Officer of LoveLife, South Africa's largest youth-targeted HIV/AIDS campaign, told IRIN.

According to the (Mail and Guardian) weekly newspaper, <u>40% of all pregnancies in the country are girls</u> younger than the age of 19. It cites reasons for this ranging from unavailable contraceptives, to <u>lack of sex</u> education at school and home.

The (Department of Health) on Thursday said it is alarmed at the <u>number of abortions in South Africa</u> during the 2012/2013 financial year. Speaking in Parliament, Minister Aaron Motsoaledi said <u>89,000</u> abortions took place at <u>public hospitals alone</u>.

Based on its sample of 36,000 women attending 1,445 antenatal clinics across all nine provinces, the Survey estimates that 29.5% of pregnant women (aged 15-49) were living with HIV in 2011.

ALCOHOL is a MIND-ALTERING, DEPRESSANT DRUG, which adversely affects the brain development of YOUNG PEOPLE involving MEMORY, LANGUAGE SKILLS, PROBLEM SOLVING and CONCENTRATION (University of California) . . .



Common STIs in Teens

Up to 40% of women with untreated chlamydia will develop pelvic inflammatory disease. **Chlamydia** can also cause prematurity, eye disease, and pneumonia in infants.

HPV causes genital warts and subclinical infection with no symptoms. There is currently no treatment for subclinical HPV and the disease can lead to cervical, penile, and anal cancer.

Gonorrhea is a major cause of pelvic inflammatory disease, infertility and tubal pregnancies in women.

Immediate Effects of Marijuana Use

- Inability to think or speak clearly
- Difficulty paying attention
- Loss of short-term memory
- Lack of coordination, slowed reaction time
- Increased heart rate and appetite
- Unusual sensitivity to sights and sounds

Long-Term Effects of Marijuana Use

- Problems with normal body development in young users
- Damage to lung tissue and the immune cells that fight cancer
- Feelings of anxiety and panic

Pierre started working with Youth in 1999. In mid-2002, he got involved in community transformation, working with people from all walks of life - from the poorest of the poor - to churches - businesses - NGO's - schools, and the Mayoral offices. He counselled, reached out to, and inspired thousands of youth across many schools, also reaching out to many of their families. He mentored many youth, as well as some of their parents. He has been involved in many community upliftment initiatives since 2002, reaching out to the destitute and hopeless, working alongside many Schools, NGO's, the SAPS, Correctional Services, Child Welfare, Child Protection, and the Dept. of Justice. He assisted the Dept. of Justice and the SAPS with counselling of family members who were traumatized by domestic violence. He is a also a part-time Educator @ ABET.
